



Texas Compassionate Use Program

Who: The Texas legislature passed the Compassionate Use Act in 2015 which allows patients with certain medical conditions to use medical cannabis in Texas. The program was expanded in 2019 and 2021. Qualifying conditions are as follows:

Cancer	PTSD
Autism	Epilepsy
Peripheral Neuropathies	Multiple Sclerosis
Spasticity Disorders	Alzheimer's Disease
Cerebral Palsy	Huntington's Disease
Muscular Dystrophy	ALS
Parkinson's Disease	Incurable Neurological Disorders

What: A doctor registered with TCUP can determine if your condition qualifies and write you a prescription for medical cannabis. Current meds include tinctures, lozenges, gummies and lotions. The Veterans Administration or insurance does not pay the costs of medical cannabis. The costs for doctor appointments, medicine and delivery are out of pocket. You can contact the dispensing organizations for info here including TCUP doctors and costs.
